Here is an excerpt of what wrote to Ryan from Nefco...

Arrow Transportation has been using slipcoat mra for the past few years to add a slick coating to the walls and floors of our biosolids hauling trailers. This has greatly reduced the amount of product that sticks to the boxes of our trailers, and thus, reduced the amount of shovelling required by our drivers to deliver their load of biosolids.

Cold temperatures are a problem as our trucks travel over mountain passes and into delivery sites where temperatures can range from -5C to -30C in the winter. Often, by the time our trucks arrive the biosolids have frozen solid in the trailers. By applying mra prior to loading we are able to unload the frozen product with minimal hassle.
